2. Contest will be held Saturday, August 2 at the Fayetteville Town Center at 3:00 p.m. starting with Tiny Tots. Other age groups will follow as listed above. Contestants must sign in at registration table at 2:30 p.m. (Table will be located near the entrance).
3. Contestants will compete in two categories: **Western Wear/Pioneer Days Wear** and **Evening Wear**. Western Wear/Pioneer Days Wear should reflect the 1858-1861 era, when the Butterfield Overland Mail Stage Coach ran through Northwest Arkansas. Use your imagination—we want this phase to be as creative as you'd like!
4. Evening wear may be a Sunday dress or pageant gown. Ages 4-9 may be long or short; ages 10-18 must be long.
5. Winners will receive a rhinestone crown and a satin embroidered sash. Awards will be given to Runners-up. Winners will be asked to help promote and participate in the Butterfield Overland Mail Sesquicentennial Commemorative Ride, September 12-14, coordinated by Heritage Trail Partners.
